RESOLUTION

IQAC Meeting Resolution
Date: 27-09-2022

The IQAC meeting of Dhupguri Girls' College was held on the 27th of September, 2022, at 1:30 PM in the meeting room. The following resolutions were passed:

1. Read and Confirmation of the Resolution of the Previous Meeting

The resolution of the previous IQAC meeting held on **03-02-2022** was read and confirmed.

2. Initiation of One-Year Certificate Course

The Principal informed the house that the college had applied to NBU for introduction of One Year "Certificate Course" on communicative English and the NBU approved the same. Now the IQAC must think over the issue and start the course as soon as possible. The house unanimously resolved to initiate the course soon.

3. Proposal regarding MoU with IARI, Kolkata & Birpara College

The house discussed the proposal for signing MoUs with IARI, Kolkata, and Birpara College very soon following the guideline framed in the meeting dated 03-02-2022. The Principal highlighted the benefits of these collaborations, including faculty exchange, student exchange programs, and joint research projects. The proposal was unanimously approved, and the Principal was authorized to proceed with the formalities of signing the MoUs.

4. Formation of Academic Council

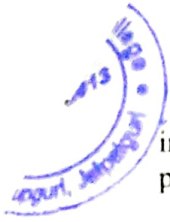
It was unanimously resolved to form an Academic Council to oversee academic matters and ensure the quality of education. The council will consist of senior faculty members and will be responsible for curriculum development, academic planning, and maintaining academic standards.

5. Initiation of Organic Farming in the College Campus

The principal informed the house that more than 80% students of the college hail from backward families and the problems of our farmers are –

1. Costly inputs
2. Hazardous farm inputs
3. Land depends on chemical inputs
4. Health deterioration of the farm lands etc.

Yet it is observed that the farmers have left over hands. The college may initiate spread of organic farming practices among the students by doing the same in the college campus. The proposal to initiate organic farming on the college campus was discussed and approved unanimously. The project aims to promote sustainable agricultural practices and provide hands-on experience to students. A team will be formed to plan and



implement the project and build on the programme in a interactive way with students participation.

6. Miscellaneous

Social Outreach Program: The house unanimously resolved to organize various social outreach programs to engage departments and students in community service and social activities.

Discussion regarding NSS Activities Beyond the Campus: The house resolved for expanding NSS activities beyond the campus to include more community-based projects and collaborations.




Possibilities of MoU with NGOs: The possibility of signing MoUs with local NGOs to facilitate community service and outreach programs were discussed and approved. The Principal is requested to identify suitable NGOs and initiate the MoU process.

Dept. Wall Magazine: The Principal proposed to build 5 wall magazines in front of each Honours Dept.. He engaged the IQAC to inculcate the practice of creating wall magazine every year under the leadership of 6th semester students. The house unanimously resolved that all honours dept. will continue and encourage the students to showcase their ideas through wall magazines of the dept. along with IQAC and Women Cell.

The IQAC Coordinator also raised the proposal of inclusion of BMOH of Dhurguri Rural Hospital and an Industrialist in the IQAC body of the college as an external administrative member discussed in the GB meeting dated 23/08/2022. The house discussed the matter seriously and unanimously resolved to send a formal invitation to the BMOH, Dhurguri Rural Hospital to accept the proposal to act as a honourable external administrative member in the IQAC of the college.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.
